I WAS JUST THINKING . .

It’s Back To School time!!!! Seneca Valley, Eden Christian, and Pine Richland started this past Wednesday. Mars will start this upcoming Wednesday, and North Allegheny and Butler Area on Thursday. The buses will be running, class will be in session, and our students will be learning all sorts of new things. Whether they are just entering kindergarten, or starting their senior year, there is much to learn and do, and so many ways to grow at school.

But academic growth is not the only learning to which we are called. We are also called to grow in our knowledge of who God is, and what God has done! And there is no better way to do that than by attending Sunday School. CCUPC is proud to offer age appropriate classes for 3 year olds through 5th graders. They’ll be learning about God and getting acquainted with the well-known stories of our faith.

New this year, we will have specific options for the 6th-12th graders. The first will be an in-depth study of the gospel of Matthew. We’ll read through the book, asking questions like “Where is Jesus in this story?” “What is challenging about this passage?” “How might we apply the principles of this passage to today?” The other option for 9th-12th grades (and college students!) will be a “Generation Change” class that will help prepare you for your future and teach you that how you treat money affects and reflects your faith.

But we don’t just have options for school-aged people. We have several adult classes ranging from an in-depth study of a biblical book to a topical women’s class, and a class taught by Pastor Jim.

Sunday School is a critical part of our church life. Worship alone is not enough to help us learn and grow in our knowledge of the Bible. Plus, by participating in a Sunday School class, you get to know more people – maybe different people from those you sit next to in the sanctuary. You can build relationships, pray for each other, and feel connected in different ways than you might simply by attending worship, or even serving on a committee. Even if you can’t attend a Sunday School class every week, don’t let that keep you from participating at all. We will gladly welcome you whenever you can come.

It is the start of a new program year at CCUPC. We do pray that you will consider joining a Sunday School class, growing in your faith, and together praising our God!
