I WAS JUST THINKING. . . by Pastor Jim

As you well know, I am a committed movie buff who thinks nothing of repeating my viewing of particular films many times. My wife does not get it wondering why anyone would want to see a movie more than once. It has been my experience that with repeated viewings you pick up nuances that were missed the first time. Anyway, that's my story and I'm sticking with it!

One film I have seen a number of times is *Titanic*, a fictionalized version of the sinking of the largest ocean luxury liner of the time on its maiden voyage in the early morning hours of April 14, 1912. I recently discovered some interesting facts about the true historical event, and I trust that the facts are accurate. They indicate that signals of distress pierced the dark night of the North Atlantic in all directions from the magnificent but ill-fated ship, the *Titanic*. The *S.S. Californian* was the nearest ship to the scene of the accident. It would have required only about one and a half hours for the *Californian* to have reached the *Titanic* as it sank. This was later acknowledged by the commanding officer of the *Californian*. Still the *Californian* never reached the place where the *Titanic* sank.

At the investigation of the sinking of the *Titanic* in Washington, D.C., Senator William Smith of Michigan asked the commanding officer why the *S.S. Californian* did not sail immediately to the scene of the accident when the distress call reached her. The officer shifted uncomfortably in the witness chair. Then he explained that they had feared icebergs. So they were lying motionless in the water. Even more importantly, he explained, they had extinguished their fires and had no steam up.

In an article in *Decision* magazine which referenced this story, the author wrote: “Such was the explanation given as to why the *Californian*, which could have reached the *Titanic* before it sank, never got there and never rescued a single soul. No fire, no power, no one rescued’ Could that be said about us that we have the form of religion, but not its power? We bear the name of Christ, but we lack the power to be His people in the world today because we have neglected that third person of the Holy Trinity the Holy Spirit. Come into our hearts, Lord Jesus, by the power of Your Holy Spirit. In the name of the Spirit, Son, and Father. Amen.”
