**DID YOU KNOW.....** that we have a staffed infant and toddler nursery available for you to use during worship? Children through age 2 are welcome to come and play. There is also a curtained off corner in the nursery for those who may need some privacy which can be used for nursing or for soothing your child. Additionally, we have the TLC ministry for those who are 3 years old through Kindergarten where children may go after the Children's Lesson. The KFC program is for children in 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> grades and leave after the Children's Lesson out the back of the sanctuary. Older children can find worksheets and coloring pages on a table in the Sanctuary near the side entrance. Any of our ushers or nursery workers will be glad to show you how to locate our nursery or children's ministries and supplies. We love having so many growing families in church!

**I WAS JUST THINKING... by Pastor Dena**

Did you know that Pittsburgh has approximately 1,200 people who are experiencing homelessness? But fewer than 100 of them actually live outdoors. That means that the remaining 1,100 live in shelters and in temporary places. One of the missions of the L.I.V.I.N.G. Ministry, an organization with which our Mission Committee partners from time to time, is to help those who are living on the streets and those who live in temporary places move into more permanent housing. But simply having a home does not end the struggle. While we praise God for the blessings of shelter, life is still hard for these folks who are trying support themselves. Many do not have the resources to properly furnish or equip their new apartment, and it often takes them almost 6 months before they have simple things like can openers or cleaning supplies.

In an effort to help, youth and families from our church assembled 25 "Welcome Home" baskets last week. We filled the baskets with basic items such as plates, glasses, paper towels, toilet paper, dish towels, and cleaning supplies. While they won't meet every need, it is our hope that these baskets will be a blessing to those who are working to become more stable in their living arrangements. They are on display in the Greeting Area until we can arrange delivery. Be sure to take a look at them, and as you do, pray for the residents who will receive them, that they would be successful in their efforts to improve their situation, and, most of all, that they would know they are a cherished child of God, and that they are fiercely loved by their Creator.

If you are interested in making a difference in the lives of those who are experiencing homelessness, consider volunteering at the ALIVE workday on November 10<sup>th</sup>. Details can be found on a flyer on the mission table in the greeting area. There is very little cost to this event (a \$5-\$10 donation and a few hours of your time), but the impact could be life changing for you and for those you serve. Please consider sharing the Good News of the Gospel by serving those in need.
